What are the rules concerning sports physicals?
The Clark County School District and the Nevada
Interscholastic Activities Association (NIAA) require
all participants joining interscholastic athletics to
pass a physical examination by a licensed
physician/provider. A complete physical
examination is required every 2 years.

BACK TO SCHOOL TIPS

Create a homework routine

Helping your child develop work habits from a young age will set them up with important life skills they'll use daily as adults. Build in plenty of time for homework.

- Be there to help troubleshoot, but don't do their homework for them.
- Create a calm, quiet, and distraction-free
 workspace for them.
- Establish a no-electronic-devices rule during homework time.
- Help them organize themselves if needed.



Stay Alert

Give way to buses pulling out – watch for bus flashing lights.

Park and turn legally around schools

Avoid dangerous maneuvers like Uturns and three-point turns.

Always give way to pedestrians, especially when entering and leaving driveways

Adjust your route to avoid school zones.

Stop for buses. Passing a stopped school bus is against the law.

Respect the school crossing guard.

Know the law about driving near school buses.

Follow the rules when picking up and dropping off children at school.


