



NOTICE OF ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Spring Mountain Road Phase I — Pedestrian Crossing Signal

Clark County Department of Public Works (CCPW) is reaching out to inform you of upcoming construction activity on Spring Mountain Rd. and Arville St.

The project is located at the intersection of Spring Mountain Road and Arville Street. Improvements consist of ADA ramp, median island, sidewalk retaining wall and a pedestrian signal east of Arville St.

Please drive safely in the work zone areas and be advised of the following:

- Some lanes will be restricted, reduced, or closed at various times for the duration of the project.
- Message boards will be placed in advance to provide notice for traffic control changes.
- Local traffic is encouraged to use alternate routes whenever possible.
- The contractor will ensure that driveway access within traffic control setups will be maintained. The contractor will coordinate with properties whose driveways will be directly affected.

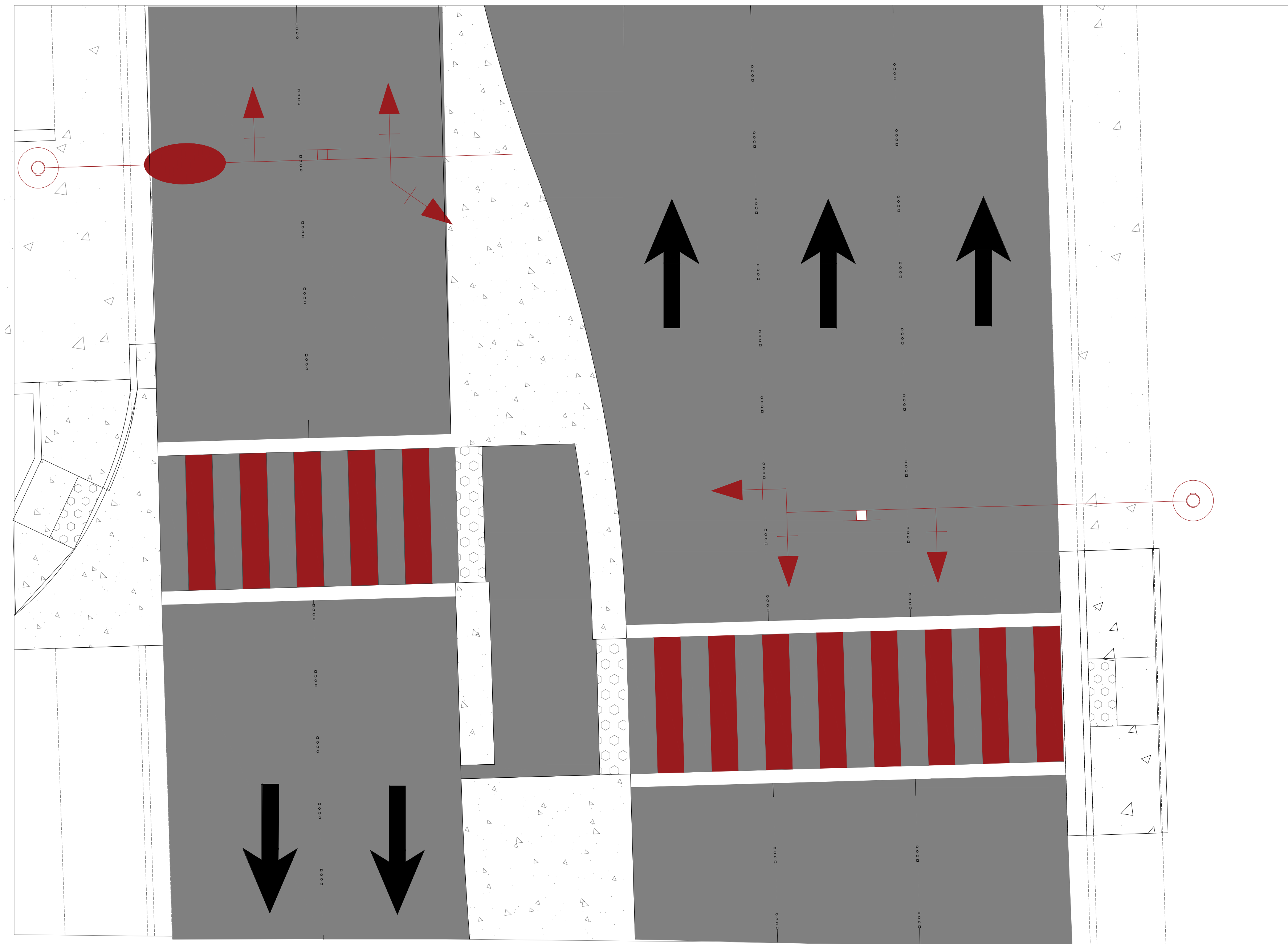
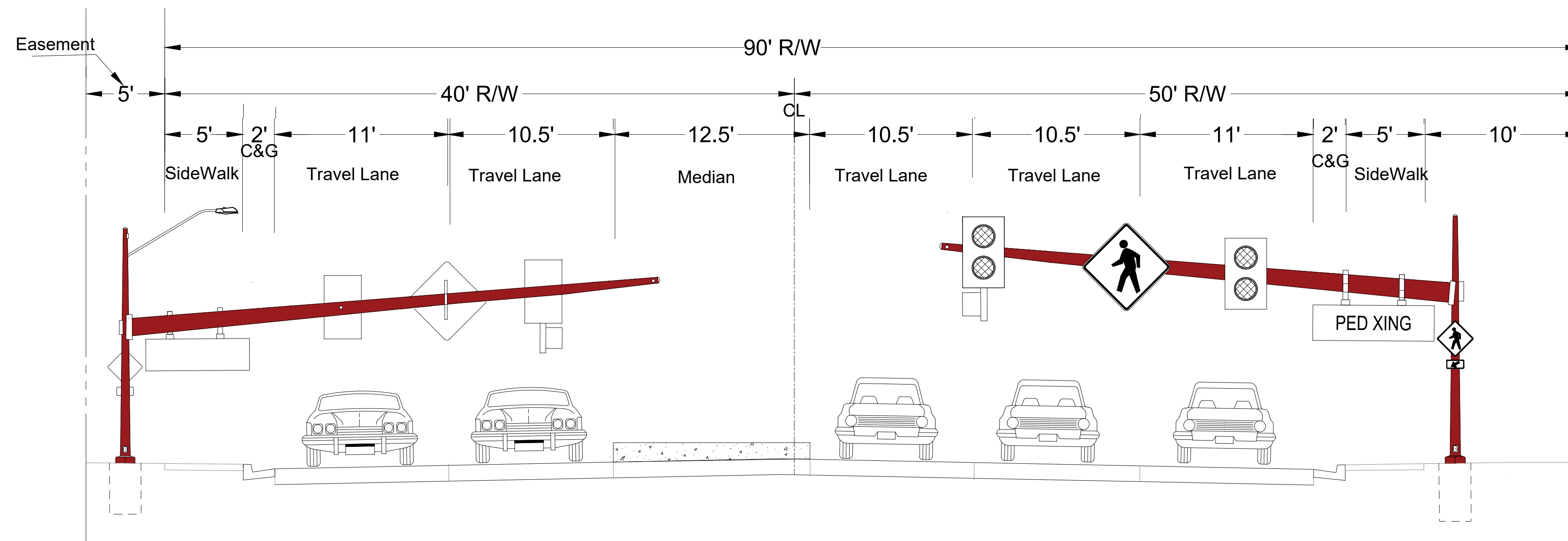
