CREATE AN ACCOUNT IN THE DUST PERMITTING PORTAL

You will need to create an account in the portal to register for dust class and to submit DCOP application.

To create an account in the portal:

- Click on **Government** at the top of the screen.
- In the dialog box that opens, click on **Department Directory**.
- Scroll down to the **Environment and Sustainability** tile (square) and click.
- Click on **Division of Air Quality** on the left side.
- Click on **Dust Control Permitting Portal, Forms & Requirements**.
- Click on **Dust Control Permitting Portal**.





Do you need a dust control operating permit?

A Dust Control Operating Permit is required for soil disturbing or construction activities 0.25 acres or greater in overall area, mechanized trenching one hundred (100) feet or greater in length, mechanical demolition of any structure one thousand (1,000) square feet or larger, or for Temporary Commercial Activities 0.25 acres or greater in overall area.

Dust Control Operating Permit for Construction Activities Application fee \$188 per acre	APPLY
Implosion Dust Control Operating Permit Application fee \$17,062 and \$188 per acre	APPLY
Temporary Commercial Activity Permit Application fee \$0	APPLY
