- **Early Voting:** \$17-\$20/hour
- **Election Day:** \$200-\$250 (flat)
- **Training Pay:** \$50 for each class (Training begins 3/2/2026)

When (Work Dates):

Primary Dates:

- Primary Early Voting - 5/23/26 to 6/5/26
- Primary Election Day - 6/9/26

General Dates:

- General Early Voting - 10/17/26 to 10/30/26
- Election Day - 11/3/26

Eligibility Requirements:

All election workers must meet all of the requirements below:

- Be a registered voter in Clark County, NV, or, be enrolled in High School and at least 16 years of age
- Not be a candidate or relative of a candidate for nomination or election in 2026
- Not be a poll watcher or observer during the election you are working
- Successfully complete the Election Department's training
