 - a. Purpose of the Safety and Justice Challenge: A national initiative funded by the MacArthur Foundation to reduce over-incarceration by changing how local justice systems use jails. It supports data-driven reforms that make the system fairer, more efficient, and more equitable.
 - b. The Sequential Intercept Model (SIM) is a framework used to identify key points—or "intercepts", along the criminal justice continuum where individuals with behavioral health needs can be diverted from deeper system involvement through community-based treatment, support, and services. It helps communities plan interventions from initial contact with law enforcement through reentry after incarceration.
