

<p><b>MYRANDA BAIR</b></p> <p>2900 South Casino Drive (Harrah's)</p>	<p>Bair is a painter of creatures and Victorian patterns, two visual references which together show the desert as home for bird and reptile, a space to lounge in the sun, as residents gathered in the front parlors of Queen Anne homes.</p>
<p><b>MARK BRANDVIK</b></p> <p>3801 Needles Highway (By Gilligan's) 3188 Needles Hwy (Front of Strip mall)</p>	<p>With images of buses, bikes, and private planes that never reach a destination, Brandvik's tour of the desert defines theatrical isolation. The transportation artifacts sitting at the bottom of a former sea are part of a collection that began with covered wagons.</p>
<p><b>JOEY DERUY</b></p> <p>2100 South Casino Drive (By Colorado Belle) 2200 South Casino Drive (Across from Pioneer)</p>	<p>Travelers through this barren land sometimes saw distant visions, but they were not always mirages. Deruy shows us pioneers also saw colors and patterns, revealing vistas unchanged by the invasion and infiltration of civilization.</p>
<p><b>LISA DOLAN</b></p> <p>2820 Needles Highway (Near Post Office ) 2897 Needles Highway (At Palm Terrace)</p>	<p>These ZAP boxes include urban scenes of children playing, earning some direct New York street cred. In the hands of Lisa Dolan they allow us to think of the small connections between two very different neighborhoods beside a river.</p>
<p><b>FAWN DOUGLAS</b></p> <p>2001 South Casino Drive (Chevron by The Edgewater)</p>	<p>Preservation and Paiute petroglyphs are the charge of this artist activist, and she also gifts ZAP 8 with indigenous beauty. A young bird dancer floats on a sweep of cobalt and turquoise, colors that represent the river and water birds.</p>
<p><b>ALI FATHOLLAHI</b></p> <p>Needles Highway (Front of Las Palmas Apartments and Las Palmas School)</p>	<p>This box is painted with detailed richness derived from a global art tradition, as striking as blooming flora in the desert. The little dice are a clue that the original homeland of the artist and his new home in Las Vegas share the romance of chance.</p>
<p><b>MAUREEN HALLIGAN</b></p> <p>3023 Needles Highway (Front of the Mobile Station)</p>	<p>ZAP 8 may have been Halligan's last project as a grad student at UNLV, where her painting has grown into a stunning aesthetic style. This project has her work respond to a metal box as a sculpture, and gives a final nod to the desert she has come to know.</p>
<p><b>ANNE HOFF</b></p> <p>3675 Needles Highway (Across from South Pointe)</p>	<p>Hoff reads the rocks for visual rhythms, then tops them with a melodic sky. Her colors and form are not the overused southwest tropes of desert Plein Air, but convey a rugged elegance of color and form.</p>

<p><b>KATIE HOFFMAN</b></p> <p>1700 South Casino Drive</p>	<p>Through Op Art with graphic representation Hoffman plays with the shapes of settlement along the river. Her palette of post-modernist colors play directly to the red and gold sign of the Riverside Hotel and Casino, an authentic throwback to 1964 cowboy modernism.</p>
<p><b>K. D. MATHESON</b></p> <p>1555 South Casino Drive (Laughlin Nevada Chamber of Commerce)</p>	<p>Matheson has applied his style to many ZAP projects; in some ways his are the original faces of regional utility boxes converted into public art. That adds meaning to a project created by the hands of local artists, who live to paint in the desert.</p>
<p><b>ORLANDO MONTENEGRO</b></p> <p>2455 Needles Highway (At Bruce Woodbury Drive near Laughlin Storage. Main Intersection)</p>	<p>Montenegro's images of good luck show his familiarity with the local industry. There is no mystery in his easy-to-read symbolism, which shows that public art is not necessarily about images wrapped in abstraction. It can also be about easy access to ideas and stories.</p>
<p><b>ERICA OTT</b></p> <p>Needles Highway (Next to Spirit Mountain Activity and Senior Center)</p>	<p>Erica Ott balances the abstraction of colorful swirls with graceful birds in flight, whose feathers seemingly float to the ground, waiting for a soft landing on sand, road, or water. This ZAP 8 box is about life in the desert and mountains throughout the state of Nevada.</p>
<p><b>ANDREA PAVLES</b></p> <p>2093 El Mirage Way (Across from St John the Baptist Catholic Church)</p>	<p>The riverbanks can be a playful site where children see the life it supports: Birds, reptiles and, of course, many species of fish. Yet to kids, edible fish do not come from river waters. There are other special places, like the deep pockets of a grandparent.</p>
<p><b>CAITLYN SAVILLE</b></p> <p>2099 Thomas Edison (At Bruce Woodbury)</p>	<p>Visitors and pioneers have discovered their personal spirituality in the experience of the desert. These ZAP 8 works by Saville reflect that visual mediation, and her public paintings become roadside shrines for non-denominational drive-by reflection.</p>
<p><b>CHRISTOPHER TSOURAS</b></p> <p>Highway 163 (At South Casino Drive)</p>	<p>Shades of green anchor desert colors painted in geometrical form are paired with active lines. Alive with movement, this painted reminder says Laughlin is more than a spartan desert junction. Laughlin is a port that dances with the energy of the Colorado River.</p>
<p><b>OSZY VILLATE</b></p> <p>46 East Civic Way (Near Clark County Fire Department Station 76)</p>	<p>Villate's boxes make a closing statement, regardless of alphabetical order, because they befit a close community. The patriotic post-Pop Art finale salutes civic resources and artists sharing the ambition to site their work next to the biggest river in the American West.</p>

ZAP 8 gathered sixteen artists to paint up to sixty-four utility boxes featuring Laughlin, Nevada in the spirit of public art. Subtitled "Zapped by the River," the project is funded by the Clark County Percent for the Arts Program and presented by Clark County Parks and Recreation, Clark County Commissioner Steve Sisolak, and the Laughlin Town Advisory Board.


