Riparian Reserves Unit Maintenance

The work for the above referenced project has been completed. Below is a summary of project related information.

The purpose of the above referenced project was:

The Clark County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP) requires the acquisition and management of riparian property along the Muddy and Virgin Rivers to provide habitat for rare and/or listed birds. The County has added a small number of acres into conservation ownership and these acquisitions require property maintenance. This project provides property maintenance and the maintenance of riparian habitats on the Muddy River and Virgin River Reserves.

The major accomplishments or findings of this project include:

Maintenance was conducted across the County properties. The contractor conducted vegetation maintenance, including removal of trees/vegetation and debris along access roads and fences. Fences and gates were repaired as requested on the County properties, due to environmental wear and degradation. A marker post was installed at monitoring well MW1 on Muddy River parcel A. Continued maintenance on County property is recommended.
