Child Haven is a licensed emergency shelter providing safe, nurturing, and temporary care for children, teens, and sibling groups who cannot safely remain with their families. Child Haven is an initial placement for about 27% of children and teens entering foster care in Clark County.

Services for children at Child Haven

- Medical screenings and treatments
- Mental health assessments and care coordination from campus clinicians
- Placement team to locate relative, kinship, or foster caregivers
- New clothing and personal care items
- Supportive staff and a safe place to live
- Special events and celebrations hosted by community partners
