

- a. Ab 415 This bill allows government to remove abandoned vehicles in the right of way and to dispose of them much quicker
- b. Ab 211- This allows us to go after bad landlords and appoint someone to fix up the property
- c. Ab 231 Requires a service contract to impose certain duties on the provider of the service contract regarding Home Warranties
- d. Ab 417- This requires a safety inspection on cars that are impounded because of trick driving.



Nevada DMV Northeast/Mesquite Locations

- A kiosk is located in the Smith's grocery store at 350 North Sandhill Blvd, that handles registration-related transactions, and we strongly encourage customers to go there before coming into the DMV. It is even available to people on weekends and evenings when the DMV office is closed.
- 2. With the new Turbo Titles program, customers must bring their paperwork into an office to verify after they complete their online transaction. We have set aside prioritized appointments for these people which is pushing appointments out a bit. This will be fixed soon when the entire Turbo Title transaction can be completed online.
- 3. Renewing a registration is the #1 transaction at all DMV offices. With kiosks and online renewal being so easy, the DMV is asking folks to try the online or kiosks systems first before heading into the DMV. Whenever someone says they are technology-challenged, we say "do you order things from Amazon?" The answer is usually "yes." With kiosks, AAA offices and online options, there is little reason for someone to come into an office for a registration renewal
