Lock Out - Tag Out Guidelines for Clark County

Clark County will now be implementing a “Lock Out - Tag Out” procedure. Based on the issues Clark County is experiencing with licensees failing to complete work and obtain proper final inspections for Encroachment Permits relating to the installation of wireless facilities.

This procedure shall be enforced on a case-by-case basis if/when a licensee does not complete and obtain an approved final inspection by Clark County Public Works Construction Management – Development Division for the installation of wireless facilities (new or upgrade) within the six (6) month timeframe provided at the time of permit issuance.

Clark County Public Works Construction Management – Development may disconnect the power to the wireless site at the service pedestal or pull box and issue a “Lock Out – Tag Out” notice after shutdown.

The licensee shall be responsible to reach out to Clark County Construction Management – Development Division to discuss options for reconnecting the site and/or removal of all installed facilities from the Clark County right-of-way.

Clark County Public Works Construction Management – Development Division shall consider this to be the **first and final notification** of this policy and procedure. All necessary coordination and design must be completed prior to permit issuance.
