The purpose of the above referenced project was:

The purpose of this project is to verify and expand upon records from 2018 of small mammal species currently present at the Boulder City Conservation Easement (BCCE). The second round of surverys will verify previous findings and to get a more comprehensive record of small mammals on this property.

The major accomplishment or findings of this project include:

During the course of this project, small mammal surveys were completed in each of the habitats represented within the BCCE. Data was collected and processed for 2,200 trap nights. One hundred and thirty-nine small mammals were trapped from eight different species. The resulting species inventory list and location data will serve as a record for future comparisons.
