

## CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY TRAINING

### 2-Part Training for Foster Caregivers

Foster Caregivers are required to understand and apply best practices to ensure children are transported safely. This includes demonstrating proper installation of a Child Passenger Safety Seat (car seat) for any foster child ages 0-6 years old (or up to 60 pounds).

### IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

To complete the 2-Part Child Passenger Safety Training, follow the steps below:

#### **Part 1 CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY TRAINING (Online)**

- Create a caregiver account for each adult at Just in Time Training: <https://www.jittrainingnetwork.org/>
- Search for the course: **Child Passenger Safety 2025/26 (1.5 Credit Hours)**
- Watch the training video in its entirety
- Complete the quiz and print your certificate

Required: Bring your **Part 1 Certificate of Completion** to your scheduled Part 2 appointment and provide a copy to the certified Child Passenger Safety Technician (CPST)

#### **Part 2 CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY SEAT INSTALLATION (In-Person)**

Contact Family Services to be assigned to a Child Passenger Safety Technician (CPST)

- **A Technician will contact you directly to schedule your installation appointment**

#### **When scheduling, be prepared to provide:**

- Confirmation of Part 1 completion
- Confirmation caregiver has a car seat appropriate for your licensed age range
  - *A 3-in-1 Car Seat Convertible Car Seat is recommended*
  - *Manufacturer label (located on the bottom or side of the seat)*

#### **How to Prepare for PART 2 INSTALLATION**

- Practice installing the car seat in the vehicle you will use to transport the foster child
- Be prepared to install the car seat independently during your appointment
- Caregivers must demonstrate correct installation to successfully complete the requirement

#### **Upon successful completion:**

You will receive a **Part 2 Certificate of Completion** from the CPST.
