The work for the above referenced project has been completed. Below is a summary of project related information.

The purpose of the above referenced project was:

The Clark County Desert Conservation Program (DCP) is required to provide Public Information and Education per the terms of the Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). The County uses a mascot named Mojave Max for Public Information and Outreach Events to encourage respect, protection, and enjoyment of natural ecosystems in Clark County. The DCP has used the Mojave Max Mascot since 1995 and wishes for Las Vegas Character Parties to provide the Mojave Max Mascot appearances.

The major accomplishments or findings of this project include:

The Mojave Max Mascot attended 63 events throughout the contract year. They provided entertainment for children at outreach events, posing for photos and interacting with members of the public. They attended school assemblies, homeschool events, and public education events across Clark County. They participated in skits and demonstrations to educate the public on the Mojave Desert.
