Notes & Highlights

- 1- The Public Response Office handles complaints related to Clark County Ordinances - Titles 7, 9, 11, 14, 22, and 30.
- 2- This value includes first, second, and third citations for the same vehicle. In mid-April 2025 we began proactive enforcement for illegal commercial vehicle parking.
- 3- These calls are handled by Animal Control Officers working to cover over 8,000 square miles within unincorporated Clark County.
- 4- This value represents the number of Animal Protection Services Fix-It Tickets Issued by Animal Control Officers. If the owner does not fix the violation, it will require a court appearance.
- 5- This statistic was added in 2025 and shows the percentage of cases closed during the month where voluntary compliance was obtained for Neighborhood Nuisance and Sign cases.
- 6 - August 2025, STREET began proactive STR enforcement.
- 7 - As of December 17, 2025, enforcement of unpermitted short term rental cases were paused due to a federal injunction.
