NOTICE OF ROAD CONSTRUCTION

607624-25 Flamingo Wash – Cimarron Branch, Russell Rd to Patrick Ln
Patrick Lane – Durango Drive to Rainbow Blvd

Clark County Department of Public Works (CCPW) is reaching out to inform you of upcoming construction activity along the Flamingo Wash - Cimarron Branch from Russell Rd to Patrick Ln and Patrick Lane from Durango Dr to Rainbow Blvd.

The project is located along the Flamingo Wash – Cimarron Branch from Russell Road to Patrick Lane as well as Patrick Lane from Durango Drive to Rainbow Blvd and consists of concrete lined storm drain channel, storm drain installation, utility relocations, roadway construction and widening, striping and signage, etc.

Please drive safely in the work zone areas and be advised of the following:

- Residential, commercial, and emergency access will be maintained at all times.
- Traffic lanes will be reduced or shifted, but at least one lane in each direction with a dedicated turn lane at signalized intersections will remain open during active construction unless otherwise posted.
- Existing pedestrian and school routes will be maintained at all times.
- Detours are expected during construction.
- Advance warning signs, message boards, and flaggers will be used to safely guide motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians through the work zone.
