The work for the above referenced project has been completed. Below is a summary of project related information.

The purpose of the above referenced project was:

The purpose of this project is to reduce the amount of tamarisk and enhance the environmental conditions on site for the benefit of riparian avian species. This will be along the Clark County Virgin River Riparian Reserve Units.

The major accomplishments or findings of this project include:

The removal and mastication of tamarisk trees was conducted on the Riparian Reserve Bunkerville Units. Approximately 50 acres at Bunkerville East and West were treated for tamarisk, clearing the way for native vegetation. The properties will be monitored and treated for tamarisk resprouts.
