The work for the above referenced project has been completed. Below is a summary of project related information.

The purpose of the above referenced project was:

The purpose of this project is to conduct routine maintenance of the habitat within the Boulder City Conservation Easement (BCCE). Routine maintenance activities included: Collecting and removing trash from the BCCE, surveying and providing maintenance to fencing on the property, clearing out desert tortoise (DT) guards and culverts, and infilling eroded areas around fencing, guards, and culverts.

The major accomplishments or findings of this project include:

Maintenance was conducted throughout the BCCE. Fencing repairs and inspections were completed. Illegally dumped materials were removed and disposed of from multiple sites. Cattle crossing guards were cleaned of debris and inspected. The public continues to illegally dump on the easement, so regular maintenance is needed to continue.
