The purpose of the above referenced project was:

The purpose of this project is to protect the BCCE from illegal vehicle traffic and to clean up the BCCE by removing trash from the sides of open roads on the easement. Trash that is dumped on the BCCE or created by shooting activities can be ingested by wildlife, such as desert tortoises and injure or kill the animals.

The major accomplishment or findings of this project include:

Seven cattle guards were removed from open roads onto the BCCE and barriers were constructed to prevent traffic from entering the closed roads. Trash was removed from the sides of over 20 miles of open roads and the illegal pet cemetery area was cleaned up.
