

## **NOTICE OF ROAD CONSTRUCTION**

Rainbow Blvd Blue Diamond to CC215 Beltway | Durango Dr and Oquendo Rd

Clark County Department of Public Works (CCPW) is reaching out to inform you of upcoming construction activity on Rainbow Boulevard from Blue Diamond Road to Clark County 215 Beltway (CC215) as well as work at the intersection of Durango Drive and Oquendo Road.

The primary project location is along Rainbow between Blue Diamond and the CC215 Beltway with additional work occurring at the Durango and Oquendo intersection. Construction activity along Rainbow will include various traffic signal improvements, pavement rehabilitation, sidewalk and ramp upgrades to ADA compliance, storm drain improvements, street light LED replacement, striping and signage. At Durango and Oquendo, work consists of the installation of a new traffic signal, ADA ramps, medians, striping and signage.

## Please drive safely in the work zone areas and be advised of the following:

- Work and lane restrictions will be conducted overnight during late night and early morning hours.
- Business, school, and residential access will be maintained at all times.
- ADA compliant pedestrian routes will be maintained.
- Message Boards shall be used to provide information for detours, access changes, closures, etc.
- Flaggers will assist with traffic management, including construction ingress and egress.
