The work for the above referenced project has been completed. Below is a summary of project related information.

The purpose of the above referenced project was:

The Clark County Desert Conservation Program is required to provide Public Information and Education under the terms of the existing Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan. The County accomplishes this through a variety of outreach efforts including the implementation of the Mojave Max Education Program. The Mojave Max Education Program provides CCSD students an opportunity to learn about the Mojave Desert, desert tortoise biology, and the importance of desert conservation and responsible recreation. The County accomplishes this by hosting Mojave Max Assemblies and Tortoise Talks throughout the school year, as well as through participation in a variety of outreach events throughout the calendar year. This project will assist the County in carrying out the Mojave Max Education Program, through the consultant providing staff and logistical support to carry out education events.

The major accomplishments or findings of this project include:

Throughout the 2024–2025-year, 60 tortoise talks, 32 assemblies, 10 outreach events and 1 emergence contest were conducted through the Mojave Max program for 103 events. Through these events 8,100 participants attended, with another 3,600 participants involved in the Mojave Max Emergence Contest. The Mojave Max Education Project continues to make a significant and positive impact on youth throughout Southern Nevada. For future events, the continuation of updates and enhancements to educational materials will be great to improve the range of services provided to the community.
