

Requirements for Fabricator Approval

Notes:

- **Failure to obtain approval prior to start of fabrication will result in an engineering work plan requirement per Technical Guideline [TG-50](#), [appendix C](#) for the applicable project permit(s).**
- **Fabricator/Manufacturer facility locations, which are shown as the report holder or listee on nationally recognized listing reports and it can be confirmed that they are performing work within the scope and limitations of the respective listing report, are exempt from the fabricator approval application process.**

Clark County has implemented fabricator approval requirements to satisfy the International Building Code section 1704.2.5 requirement.

Clark County maintains the fabricator approval process which is recognized by Clark County and its incorporated cities.

Clark County Building Administrative Code section [22.02.535](#) requires fabricator approval for:

1. Engineered structural wood products
2. Engineered structural metal products and assemblies
3. Structural metal storage racks over 8 feet in height
4. Metal stairs, balconies, and assemblies
5. Engineered metal canopies
6. Amusement and transportation systems
7. Precast and/or pre-stressed concrete product
8. Ready mix concrete
9. Exterior Insulation and Finish Systems
10. Panelized wall systems
11. Other products or systems as the Building Official may designate

Fabricators are reviewed and approved on an individual basis for each fabrication/manufacturing address location.

All fabricators are required to make an application using the Citizen Access Portal to obtain approval.
