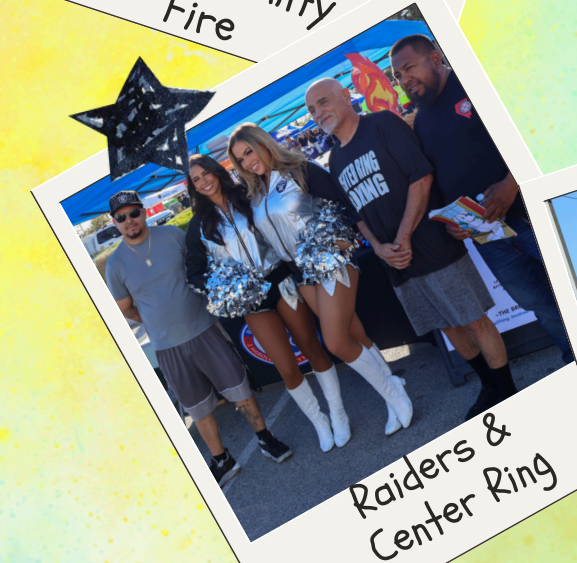

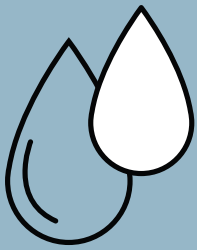

Leak Detection Assistance Program

We understand that fixing home water leaks can be costly. If you have a leak and are unable to [find and fix the leak](#) yourself, it may be time to hire a [Water Smart Plumber](#).

Single family residential property owners may request a leak detection voucher for up to \$250 that can be applied toward the initial leak diagnostic services or the first two hours of service work to fix the identified leak(s).

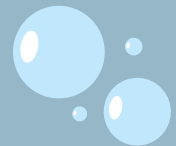
Property owners should have this voucher in hand when the Water Smart Plumber comes out to do the work, and the Water Smart Plumber will submit the completed voucher to SNWA for reimbursement. Tree Irrigation Tips



Tree irrigation

Trees should be watered well enough to penetrate the soil to a depth of 18 to 24 inches. The type of tree and the season will determine a [watering schedule](#).

Avoid these mistakes when dealing with drip irrigation for trees:

- Setting your irrigation controller for your tree to run the same as spray irrigation
- Mixing irrigation components
- Not using filters or pressure regulator
- Not properly burying drip irrigation lines
- Applying too much gravel mulch before establishing wetting patterns
- Poor emitter placement which results in poor wetting patterns
- Not maintaining the drip irrigation system

What are some things to know about Autism ?

Cognitive Strengths: Autistic individuals often have high attention to detail, a drive for perfection, and logical, technical skills, which are advantageous in fields like science, engineering, and data analysis.

Unique Perspective: Many autistic individuals are less influenced by societal norms and social biases, leading to "out-of-the-box" creative problem-solving.

Sensory and Communication Differences: Autistic people may experience sensory overload (bright lights, loud sounds) and process information differently, often preferring direct, literal communication.

Brain Differences: Research suggests a neurobiological difference with 17% lower synaptic density, which is linked to unique social-communication patterns.
