The work for the above referenced project has been completed. Below is a summary of project related information.

The purpose of the above referenced project was:

The County sought an amendment to the Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP) to more effectively balance the needs of sustainable growth and conservation in Clark County, Nevada. Ebbin, Moser + Skaggs, LLP is authorized to practice law in federal courts and before federal departments and agencies. The firm provided advocacy, legal advice, and services to the County to facilitate the amendment of the Clark County MSHCP and Incidental Take Permit in compliance with NEPA, the ESA, and related statutes, regulations, and policies. The firm provided complete, accurate, and critical reviews of regulations, correspondence, reports, and other documents related to or in support of the MSHCP Amendment. Ebbin, Moser + Skaggs, in coordination with the County, developed a strategy to amend the MSHCP and assisted with the preparation of an environmental impact statement and implementing agreement.

The major accomplishments or findings of this project include:

Ebbin, Moser + Skaggs provided legal advice to the County regarding the amendment process, including input on adjusting the mitigation fee and adding the Tule Springs acreage to the current MSHCP. The firm reviewed proposed rule adjustments and advised on corresponding changes to the amendment strategy. They also provided insight into changing federal regulations and the effects of those changes on the MSHCP amendment process.
