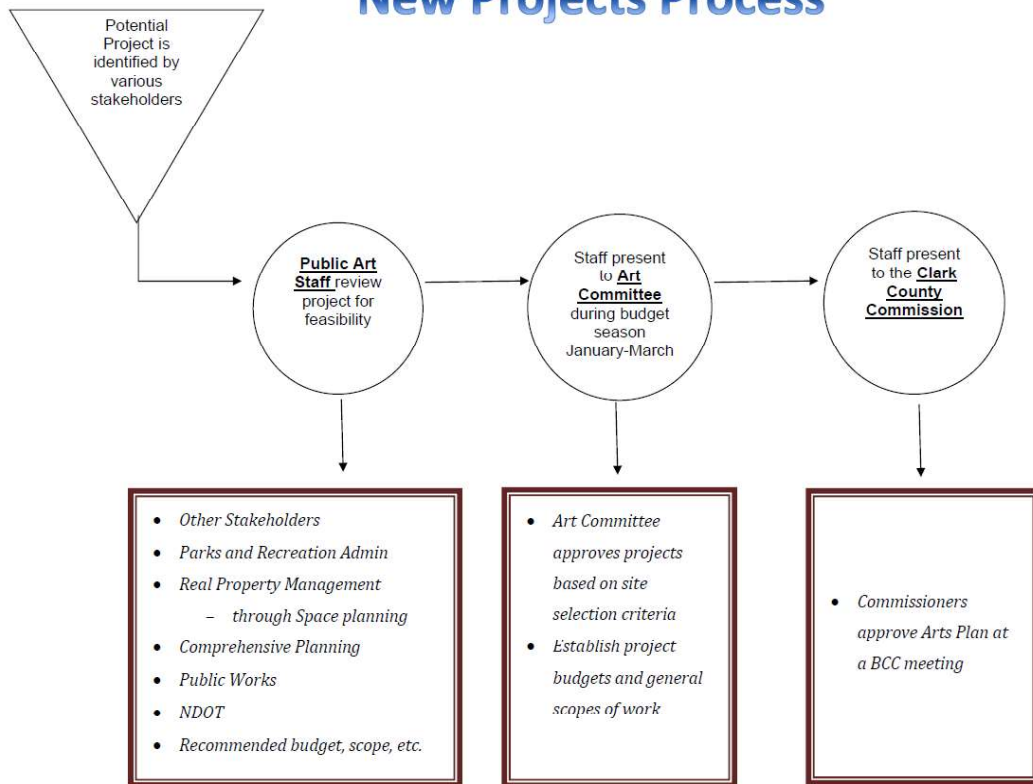

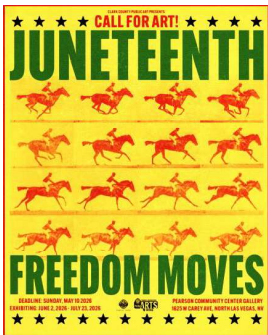

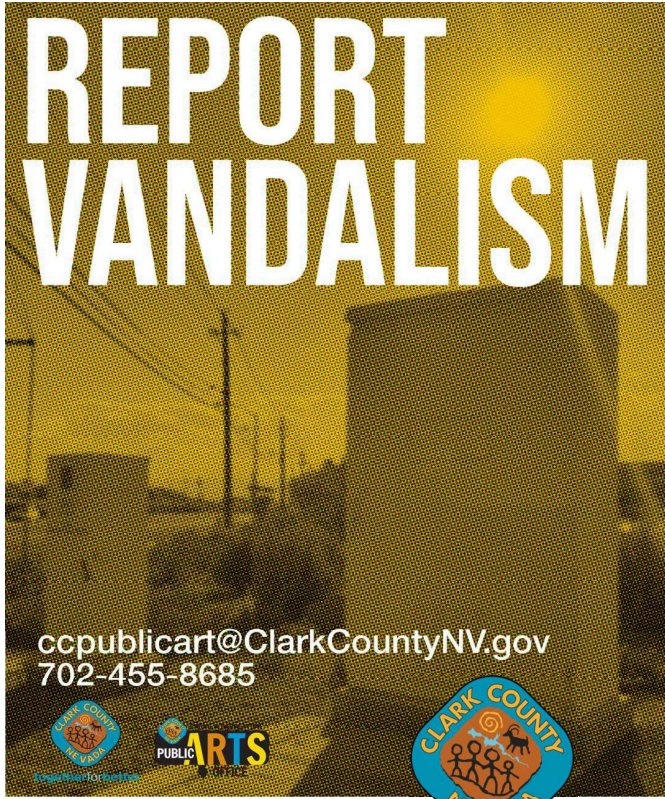

When Aku Aku opened its January doors at the Stardust Resort and Casino, it introduced a new breed of tropical entertainment to the Las Vegas Strip. At the height of American tourism with the island theme craze, the Stardust resort was the first to bring the Moai Desert Island and step into an island-themed fantasy escape by way of a resort design, resort lighting, and theatrical entertainment.



**A Giant Gaze: The Moai at Sunset Park**  
The colossal stone figure before you once stood along the glittering Las Vegas Strip, greeting visitors to the Polynesian-themed Aku Aku restaurant at the former Stardust Resort and Casino.



At the time, Americans were fascinated by what became known as the Tiki craze, an entertainment brand that blended Pacific Island motifs with dramatic decor, adventurous cocktails, and themed architecture. The moai at Aku Aku became one of the most recognizable symbols of this style on the Strip. When the restaurant closed and its themed structures were removed, Clark County stepped in to preserve this unique piece of local culture. In 2017, the sculpture was relocated to Sunset Park, where it now stands on its own island as an unexpected yet beloved landmark for all park visitors.
