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SPECIAL EVENT LIQUOR SALES RESTRICTIONS FOR ALL PACKAGE LICENSEES LOCATED WITHIN THE LAS VEGAS BOULEVARD "STRIP CORRIDOR"

Dear Licensee,

Please allow this letter to remind you of the restrictions concerning the prohibition of the sale of packaged alcohol in glass containers for licensees within the "Strip Corridor" between the hours beginning two hours before and ending two hours after any special event, this **includes the upcoming F1 Las Vegas Grand Prix scheduled for November 16-18, 2023.**

Your business is licensed for the sale of packaged alcohol and within the geographical boundaries identified in Clark County Code 8.20.287, also known as the "Strip Corridor," thus the prohibition of the sale of packaged alcohol in glass containers applies to your operations and you are encouraged to take proactive measures to prevent the removal of such containers from your premises.

12.43.020 - Possession of glass container—During specified holidays and special events.

It is unlawful for any person to be in possession of any glass container which is fit for beverage purposes or intended for beverage purposes:

- (a) While on any public street that is temporarily closed to vehicular traffic, including Las Vegas Boulevard, south of Sahara Avenue and north of Sunset Avenue, and the sidewalks bordering such public street during the following times:

...

- (3) Between the hours beginning two hours before and ending two hours after any special event as defined in Section 12.43.010.

12.43.010 Definitions.

- (a) Special Event Defined. As used in this chapter, the words "special event" mean any competitive activity consisting of running or biking races, or athletic type of activities, or other special activity which may include, but shall not be limited to, block parties, grand openings, fireworks displays or building implosions, which requires or results in the temporary closure of any public street or right-of-way.
