- Lift and move up to 50 lbs, as needed
- Ability to see fine details, with or without corrective lenses.





Developmental Milestones to Watch for

1

Cannot walk alone by 18 months

4

Only walks on tip toes, not heel-toe, after walking for several months

2

Does not imitate actions or words by two years

5

Does not know function of common household objects (brush, phone, fork, etc.)

3

Does not speak at least 15 words by 18 months

6

Does not use 2-word sentences by age 2.

Clark County invests in a temporary shelter and a supplemental shelter



In August of 2025 Clark County Commissioners invested \$3 million for a temporary emergency shelter. A further commitment was just made in February 2026 of \$39 million for an additional supplemental shelter.
