Call to Order

- The meeting called to order and a quorum was established.

Review and Approve Minutes

- The August 21, 2025, meeting minutes were unanimously approved.
- 2026–2029 strategic plan presented was approved. Unanimously approved.

Informational

I. Presentation: Campus For Hope Presentation (CEO Kim Jefferies)

- Which is Organization created to provide comprehensive wrap around services in a trauma informed environment with the goal of ending a person's homelessness.
- It is a one stop shop that will have 900 beds homeless services campus opening in summer 2028.
- Comprehensive on-site services: medical, dental, vision, behavioral health, substance use treatment, case management, legal, housing navigation, workforce development, childcare, pet facilities, and various dorms (men, women, LGBTQ, young adults, couples, families, veterans).
- Model based on San Antonio. The average stay is expected 6–9 months.
- Permanent housing is the goal. San Antonio campus achieved 91% one-year and 87% ten-year housing retention rates.
- Eligibility: Nevada residency, sobriety, no violent offenses in last 7 years, no registered sex offenders, commitment to person-centered plan (income & housing), background check, and campus volunteering/work required.
- Construction: demolition starts in weeks located near Charleston and Jones on a 20+ acres.

II. Subcommittee Updates

- Community Navigator are working on Nevada Pretrial Risk Assessment revalidation targeted for year-end completion and will provide an update to executive council.
- DV subcommittee identified subject matter experts in general DV and strangulation.
- It's ongoing stakeholder collaboration and new funding model implementation.
- DUI subcommittee postponed until January.
- Judge Bonaventure's court has been changed to monitor the impact of reduced out-call result time from 120 to 60 days on case processing through the District and Justice Court.
- Corridor Prime committee continues biweekly meetings; focuses on targeting and providing resources to specific populations.
