### Java Jaunt Birding

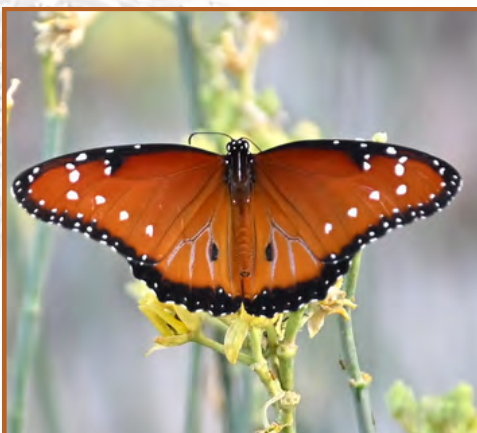

### Watercolor for Kids

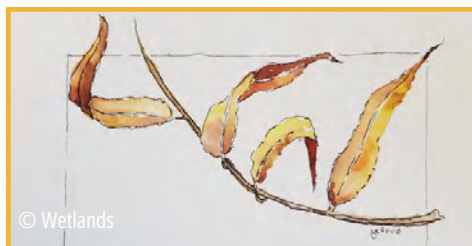

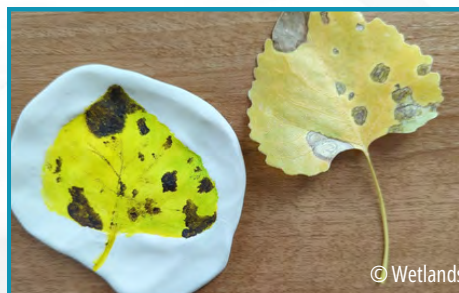
