NOTE: Clark County is soliciting and intends to award this Contract as a Nevada Prevailing Wage Public Works Project. All bidders shall prepare and submit their bids using the applicable Nevada prevailing wage rates for all labor classifications, regardless of the amount of the bidder's submitted bid.

NOTE: This is a Federally Funded Project governed by Davis Bacon Wage Decision and Section 3 provisions.

This is a Federal-aid contract and the requirements for such shall apply. On a Federal-aid contract, any Contractor otherwise qualified by the State of Nevada to perform such work is not required to be licensed nor to submit application for license in advance of submitting a bid or having such bid considered, provided, however, that such exception does not constitute a waiver of the State's right under its license laws to require a Contractor, determined to be a successful bidder, to be licensed to do business in the State of Nevada in connection with the award of the contract to him.

SCOPE OF WORK:

A 16-foot wide reinforced concrete pedestrian multi-use trail will be constructed through the wash underneath the existing vehicular bridge and the existing pedestrian bridge. The project will provide a continuous trail connection between the Legacy Trail parking area on the south side of SR 159 and the trail system on the north side of SR 159. The project scope of work will include traffic control, concrete retaining walls, 30" diameter drilled shafts, steel pedestrian railing, post and cable railing, drop inlets, removal of existing asphalt trail, new asphalt trail, 18" RCP Storm Drain, a drop inlet, concrete valley gutter, removal of riprap, new riprap, guardrail, trail signs, and trail striping.

ESTIMATED COST: \$3,601,345 - \$3,980,435.
