<u>USE PERMITS</u> for the following: 1) to allow agriculture livestock, large (horses) and agriculture livestock, small (chickens) prior to a principal use; 2) allow an increase in the number of agriculture livestock large (horses); and 3) allow accessory agricultural buildings prior to a principal use. <u>WAIVERS OF DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS</u> for the following: 1) fence height; and 2) fence setback on 0.2 acres in an R-T (Manufactured Home Residential) zone. Generally located on the south side of Encinitas Street and the west side of Lincoln Street within Searchlight.
