IDNUMBER	Clark County voter record unique identifier.
VOTER_NAME	Voter full name.
STREETNUMBER	Voter's residential street address number.
STREETPREDIR	Voter's residential street pre-direction.
STREETNAME	Voter's residential street name.
STREETTYPE	Voter's residential street type.
UNIT	Voter's residential unit.
CITY	Voter's residential city.
STATE	Voter's residential state.
ZIP	Voter's residential zip.
PRECINCT	Voter's ballot precinct.
VOTER_REG_PARTY	Voter's registered party.
BALLOT_PARTY	Party of the ballot issued (used for partisan primary only).
ELECTION_CODE	Unique election code (e.g., 10G for 2010 General Election).
REQUEST_SOURCE	NA.
REQUEST_DATE	NA.
BALLOT_MAIL_DATE	Date the ballot was mailed to the voter.
BALLOT_RECEIVE_DATE	Date the ballot was received back by Election Department.
RETURN_CODE*	Returned ballot code.

**\*NOTE:** If the RETURN\_CODE field has a value of "SNP", it is because the Election Department has noted the required signature was missing on the returned ballot envelope. If the RETURN\_CODE field has a value of "UND", it is because the post office has returned the ballot envelope as undeliverable; otherwise, this field should be blank.
