RE: Submittal of Clark County Department of Environment and Sustainability, Division of Air Quality's Second Maintenance Plan for the 1987 24-hour PM₁₀ NAAQS


Dear Mrs. Angelich:

On behalf of Governor Lombardo, as his appointed designee, this letter informs you of the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection's (NDEP) transmittal, submitted electronically to the Environmental Protection Agency's (USEPA) State Planning Electronic Collaboration System (SPeCS), of Clark County Department of Environment and Sustainability, Division of Air Quality's (DAQ) Second Maintenance State Implementation Plan (SIP) for the 1987 24-hour particulate matter less than 10 microns in diameter (PM₁₀) National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). The NDEP requests approval of the enclosed revisions into the Nevada applicable SIP.

This submittal is to fulfill requirements related to maintenance plans for the 1987 24-hour NAAQS for PM₁₀. The plan demonstrates continued maintenance of the NAAQS in the Las Vegas Valley (Hydrographic Area 212) during the first maintenance period (2014–2023) and over the next 10 years using permanent and enforceable control measures. This plan outlines how DAQ will maintain compliance with the PM₁₀ NAAQS through 2035.

This SIP revision was approved and adopted by the Clark County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) on August 5, 2025, and will satisfy the maintenance planning requirements of Section 175A(b) of the Clean Air Act (CAA).
