Must have some knowledge and passion for Public Art. Upon interview, please bring pictures or portfolio of your work. Work schedule is Monday –Thursday 1:00 pm – 5:30 pm and evening events. Part-time employment will not lead to permanent employment. Part-time hourly employees are used to fill positions normally less than twenty (20) hours per week. Part-time employees do not receive benefits.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Graphic Design: Design promotional materials such as flyers, brochures, banners, and digital assets for public art projects, gallery exhibitions, and educational programs. - Develop visuals for print and digital platforms, ensuring consistency with the county's branding and accessibility standards. - Collaborate with artists and staff to create materials communicating project goals and community impact.

Social Media Management:* - Manage and curate content for the Public Arts Office's social media channels, including Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter. - Develop and implement social media strategies to increase visibility and engagement with the community. - Monitor social media trends and analytics to inform content creation and outreach efforts.

Photography and Videography:* - Capture high-quality photos and videos of public art installations, events, and community workshops. - Edit and produce multimedia content for promotional materials and online platforms.

Community Engagement:* - Assist in planning and promoting public art events, workshops, and exhibitions. - Engage with community members, artists, and stakeholders to foster participation and support for public art initiatives.
