



NOTICE OF ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Clark County Department of Public Works (CCPW) is reaching out to inform you of upcoming construction activity on Residential Streets Pavement Reconstruction #105 (Lot 1 & 2).

The project is located at numerous residential communities and consists of residential pavement improvements. Work includes asphalt reconstruction, concrete sidewalk, curb, gutter, ADA ramps, drainage features, pavement striping and signs. In general, work on your street will be phased in this order over the course of approximately 4 weeks:

- Concrete Saw cutting activities
- Concrete removal and replacement
- Milling and paving of the roadway surface

Please drive safely in the work zone areas and be advised of the following:

- Notices will be distributed to your specific address 72 hours prior to construction activity impacts to your street.
- Access to residential streets will be restricted or reduced at various times for the duration of the project. The Contractor will ensure that outside of these working hours, access to private residences within traffic control setups will be maintained.
- Residents who will be affected directly by restricted driveway access will be notified by the Contractor. NO PARKING signage will be placed in advance of construction activities starting. On-street parking will be prohibited during construction activities.
