



NOTICE OF ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Peace Way, Hualapai Way to Cimarron Road

Clark County Department of Public Works (CCPW) is reaching out to inform you of upcoming construction activity on Peace Way, Hualapai Way to Cimarron Road.

This project will construct a bridge at Peace Way over Clark County 215 and provide roadway rehabilitation on Peace Way from Hualapai Way to Cimarron Road. The bridge will connect Peace Way at Fort Apache Road west of Clark County 215 and Chessie Court east of Clark County 215. The improvements generally consist of the bridge structure, pavement rehabilitation, curb and gutter, median, sidewalk, traffic signals, pavement markings, signing, street lighting, bridge lighting, bridge underdeck lighting, fencing, construction traffic control and other related items of work. Additionally, a traffic signal will be constructed at Hualapai Way and Peace Way.

Please drive safely in the work zone areas and be advised of the following:

- Some lanes will be restricted, reduced, or closed at various times for the duration of the project.
- This is an active construction zone, please follow the speed limit and stay aware when any work is ongoing.
- Some areas of sidewalk will be unable to access for pedestrian travel for periods of time.

Working hours are 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday to Friday. The contractor will ensure that outside of these working hours, access to private residences within traffic control setups will be maintained. Residents who will be affected directly by restricted driveway access will be notified by the contractor.
