THIRD AMENDMENT TO
THE
SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT ESG-CV**

Amendment of the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG-CV)
for the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act of 2020

The purpose of this Third Amendment of the Clark County Substantial Amendment to the 2020 Action Plan is to revise the ESG-CV spending plan to fund eligible Emergency Shelter/Non-Congregate housing activities. Clark County Community Resources Management (CRM) is proposing to reprogram **\$2,084,395.25** ESG-CV funds from rapid rehousing activities to Emergency Shelter activities in response to Covid-19 related housing needs including homeless households which are highly vulnerable to poor outcomes, as well as **\$25,000.00** from rapid rehousing to HMIS to align with HUD activity categories.
