	<b>Trees:</b> Provide 10% more than required by Title (1 pt)	
	<b>Water-Efficient Planting:</b> Provide 95% or more of plants have low or very low water needs. (1 pt)	
	<b>Landscape Buffer:</b> Exceed required buffer width by 10% (1/2 pt) <b>OR</b> exceed buffer width by 20%. (1 pt)	
	<b>Parking Lot Trees:</b> Provide mature tree canopies to cover at least 50% of paved parking. (1 pt)	
	<b>Parking Lot Solar:</b> Provide solar covers at for least 50% of the paved area (2 pts) <b>OR</b> between 25% and 50% (1 pt)	
	<b>Electric Bicycles:</b> Provide bicycle charging (1/2 pt); Provide shade to bicycle charging area (1/2 pt)	
	<b>Mojave Native Plants Protection:</b> Protect = to or > 5% of development footprint to remain natural area (1 pt)	
	<b>Mojave Native Plants Restoration:</b> Restore pre-development native plants = to or > the area disturbed. (1/2 pt)	
	<b>Energy Conservation/Solar Gains:</b> Orient plant materials south and west sides of the building. (1/2 pt)	
	<b>Cool Roofs:</b> Provide roof w/SRI=to or >78 for low sloped roofs (<2.12) & or 29 for steep sloped roofs (>2.12) (1 pt)	
	<b>Building Orientation:</b> Orient roofs within 30°of true east-west & flat or sloped to the south. (1 pt)	
	<b>Shade Structures:</b> Provide shade/awnings over 50% of south/west windows & doors (1 pt). Add 1 pt for each additional 25% (typically 3-foot min overhang)	
	<b>Amenity Zone Shade Structures:</b> Provide shade structure (ex. awning/arcade) for sidewalks or buildings adjacent to amenity zone. (1/2 pt)	
	<b>Shaded Walkways:</b> Provide for at least 60% of all building facades adjacent to or facing streets, drive aisles, and gathering and parking areas (1 pt). Each additional 10% provided. (1 pt)	
	<b>Daylighting Strategies:</b> Provide daylighting strategies to minimize artificial lighting. (1/2 pt)	
	<b>Multiple Family Ventilation:</b> Provide floor to ceiling heights of 9 feet on all floors. (1/2 pt)	
	<b>Nonresidential Ventilation:</b> Provide floor to ceiling heights of 11 feet on all floors. (1/2 pt)	
	<b>Low-emissivity Glass:</b> Provide on all south & west facing windows. (1/2 pt)	
	<b>Building Entrances and ADA Ramps:</b> Shade with awning or portico or other device. (1/2 pt)	
	<b>Alternative Energy:</b> Cover 70% roof area in solar <b>OR</b> on-site solar generates 100% of project's energy <b>OR</b> Battery backup is provided. (2 pts for provide one of the 3)
