IMPORTANT!



- ♥ Ceremony **MUST** be performed in Nevada by an officiant licensed in Nevada
- ♥ All three (3) documents **MUST** be given to the person performing the ceremony
- ♥ Someone other than the officiant **MUST** witness you saying your vows
- ♥ This marriage license is valid for one year
- ♥ Visit our website for detailed information!

REVIEW & SAFEGUARD YOUR DOCUMENTS

1.

- ♥ Check your documents for accuracy! Make corrections **BEFORE** the ceremony
 - ☑ Names are spelled correctly?
 - ☑ First, middle, and last names are in the right order?
 - ☑ Dates of birth are correct?
 - ☑ Resident information
- ♥ Corrections **AFTER** the ceremony may be subject to a fee
- ♥ Lost or stolen documents? You must reapply for your license
- ♥ Congratulations! Now go get **MARRIED!**



SAY YOUR VOWS

2.

- ♥ Pick your chapel, church, or officiant from hundreds in Las Vegas. Visit www.weddingchamber.vegas to find services
- ♥ Give your documents to your officiant: marriage license, marriage certificate, and keepsake
- ♥ Civil Marriage services may be booked online at www.ClarkCountyNV.gov/Clerk
- ♥ Get an invoice and accounting for all services rendered by your chapel/officiant **BEFORE** your ceremony

SHOW THE WORLD!

3.

- ♥ Your marriage is now **LEGALLY** recognized around the world!
- ♥ Your officiant has up to 10 calendar days to file your certificate – check at MLIC.Vegas
- ♥ A certified copy of your marriage certificate is your legal proof of marriage
- ♥ If your country requires an Apostille, it must be obtained from the state:
www.nvsos.gov/sos/businesses/apostille



The Clerk's Office will **NOT** give out phone numbers and does **NOT** solicit marriage certificate orders. Private document services may contact you to offer to obtain your marriage certificate, your Apostille, or offer expedited services. They are **NOT** affiliated with our office.

To confirm that your **marriage certificate** has been filed within the 10 days required by state law, you may search online at **MLIC.Vegas**

Certified Marriage Certificate: A certified copy of a marriage certificate is your legal proof of marriage. This certificate is required by most federal and state agencies, Social Security Admin, DMV, banking, insurance, passport, and immigration naturalization service. Marriage Certificates are available for all marriages performed from 1909 to present.

Marriage Abstract: A Marriage Abstract is a certified document that contains some of the information from the original certificate and may be used for some U.S. agencies and some foreign countries.

Certified Marriage License: If required, a certified copy of your marriage license can be obtained. Older versions of marriage certificates did not have date of birth and the license will have this information on it.

Apostilles: Are required by some countries to recognize the marriage. Please contact the Nevada Secretary of State at www.nvsos.gov/sos/businesses/apostille.

Payment: NO PERSONAL CHECKS ACCEPTED. **BY MAIL:** Money order or cashier's check in U.S. dollars from a U.S. bank. **ONLINE:** Credit card (Visa, MasterCard, or Discover). **IN PERSON:** Cash, cashier's check, money order, or credit card. Please allow up to 10 business days to receive your online order and up to 3 weeks to receive your mail-in request. International orders may take longer.
