REQUIREMENTS

You must be a Clark County resident to attend these free legal information seminars. Many provisions of these classes are governed by state laws and if you reside in another state, the information at these seminars may not apply to you.

CRIMINAL RECORD SEALING REQUIREMENTS

This class only pertains to Southern Nevada criminal records. In order to seal your criminal records, you must meet certain requirements. First, you must wait a number of years after your release, if you were in jail. The clock begins when you complete parole or probation. If you were acquitted or had charges dismissed you can seal those records right away. However, if you have gotten into trouble again since your original charges, you may not be able to get your records sealed immediately. **CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN, FELONY DUIs, and SEXUAL OFFENSES can never be sealed.**

Required Waiting Period

Crimes Against Children (NRS 179D.0357), Felony DUIs, and Sexual Offenses	Ineligible
Category A, Crime of Violence (NRS 200.408), Burglary (NRS 205.060)	10 years
Category B, C or D felony	5 years
Category E felony	2 years
Enhanceable misdemeanors (including Non-felony DUI and Non-felony battery domestic violence)	7 years
Gross Misdemeanors, Misdemeanor Battery (NRS 200.481), Harassment (NRS 200.571), Stalking (NRS 200.575), Violation of a Temporary or Extended Order for Protection	2 years
All other misdemeanors and traffic violations	1 years
Acquitted/Dismissed charges or Honorable Discharge on charge under NRS 453.3363	No wait
Charges prosecution declined to prosecute	After the Statute of Limitations has run OR 8 years after the arrest OR if agreed by parties

DIRECTIONS

The Clark County Law Library is located in downtown Las Vegas, between Bridger Ave. and Lewis Ave. It is on the east side of Third Street. **Please allow additional time to find parking.**

From I-15, take the East Charleston exit. Travel east on Charleston, turn left (north) on 4th Street, turn left on Lewis, turn right on 3rd Street. Destination is on your right.

From US-95, take the So. Las Vegas Blvd. exit. Travel south on Las Vegas Blvd., turn right on Bridger Ave., turn left on 3rd Street. Destination is on your left.
